- Learn to use corporate websites and social media accounts
- Tourist aspects visit Bavaria, Munich, Salzburg, Allianz Arena have a boat cruise on the lakes, have the opportunity to swim daily in the lake at the bottom of the Bavarian Alps. Visits to museums and sightseeing.

By this project we would like to offer the young people intercultural education, present different job profiles and prepare them to a certain extent for entry into working life. The focus of the two-week international encounter is on the dialogical exchange between the young people from Germany, Italy, Poland and Turkey. Intercultural getting to know each other and mutual acquaintance and presentation of the typical features of their homeland. The young people get the opportunity to bring their own personality into the group and to develop an understanding of other cultures, values and norms of the participating countries and to break down any



prejudices. The idea arose from the high youth unemployment in Europe. Educationally



disadvantaged young people (e.g. school dropouts) and socially disadvantaged young people are particularly hard hit.

Other key topics will be climate change, environmental protection, healthy nutrition and sustainability, and the surroundings of the ecological Seiml-Hof and the environmental station are ideal for this. The young people will learn these topics partly in group games, puzzles, small manual tasks, cooking together, dancing, creating a joint work of art, etc.

The planned international project for young people aims to connect different cultures. The project is intended to serve as a model for other organizations and regions and to introduce and present exemplary methods to all interested parties, including politicians, in order to further expand extracurricular education.

We pursue the following goals:

- Experience, understand and understand Europe through active participation

- Development of intercultural understanding, social competence within a group

- Simple conversation in a foreign language, breaking down prejudices, reflecting on one's own cultural identity

- Development and practical application of new communication methods

Seeing participatory shaping and getting involved as an opportunity, especially for young people with a migrant background, refugees and young people with disabilities
Further development and application of methods to sensitize young people to the importance of a healthy, sustainable lifestyle and environmentally conscious behavior
The project concept is made available to other interested actors as a model project and. This gives them the opportunity to set up their own international, inclusive project with a group of young people. We want to encourage imitation and further development so that the youth and young adults in Europe move closer together and for everyone involved

- Provide impulses for open youth work in the participating countries
- Remain in the European exchange and comparison of the education systems
- Contribute to current issues of the EU youth strategy and develop solution strategies



- Make young people's employability and willingness to work.
