About the project:

The training course for youth workers and youth leaders "Creative and Critical thinking skills in youth work" will take place in Rezekne, Latvia from 14.05.2022.-21.05.2022.

THE AIM OF THE PROJECT is to develop the creative and critical thinking skills of youth workers and youth leaders for the development of non-formal education.

THE PROJECT TASKS:

- To get to know different thinking methods;
- To understand the similarities and differences of creative and critical thinking;
- To understand our own way of thinking, its impact on work with young people and teamwork;
- To strengthen the understanding of the creative process and creativity-enhancing environment;
- To train the skills of generating creative ideas;
- To develop critical thinking skills;

- To exchange experiences and intercultural practices in applying creativity and innovation in the youth work;

- To create an appropriate environment for the development of new partnerships and new creative projects in the Erasmus + program;

- To provide project publicity and dissemination activities at local and international level.

Nowadays it is difficult to tell exactly what requirements will be imposed on the personality in the future. Therefore, it is important that youth workers and people who work directly with young people would be able to develop their competences, skills and abilities, including creative thinking, which provides an opportunity to adequately assess new circumstances and develop effective strategies for dealing with potential problems in youth work. Nowadays in the learning process, both in nonformal and formal education, great emphasis is placed on developing thinking skills so that young people can make more adequate and serious decisions, to develop themselves and their abilities to speak, communicate, be in society and successfully build their careers. By strengthening their competences in this field, youth workers and youth leaders will also be able to develop young people with whom they work and who may be affected by the creativity, positivism and knowledge of youth workers. In designing this project, our idea is to organize a training course for youth workers and youth leaders on the development of creative and critical thinking and their use in non-formal education, and the rethinking of creative project ideas with young people. In the current competitive environment to think "from another perspective" and "to another direction" means a lot that can produce significant results. The more complex the modern world becomes, the more creative and decisive people should be to solve different challenges of life.

Rezekne is a city in the Rēzekne River valley in Latgale region of eastern Latvia. It is called *The Heart of Latgale* (Latvian *Latgales sirds*, Latgalian *Latgolys sirds*). Built on seven hills, Rezekne borders with Russia, Lithuania and Byelorussia. It has become a border city between EU, NATO and the Eastern states. Rezekne is located 242 km from the state capital Riga, 685 km from Moscow, 450 km from St. Petersburg, and 860 km from Warsaw. It has a population of 31,216 making it the 7th largest city in Latvia.







the most significant objects of cultural history.Hotel provides wireless (WI-FI) internet connection.
Rooms will be shared from 2 till 3 persons per room of the same sex. All rooms have toilet and shower. Towels and bed linen will be provided.
Don't forget to bring your personal hygienic (shampoo, shower gel, slippers, etc.)!
Activities will be organized in the seminar hall of the hotel. 100% of the seminar costs and seminar tools are covered. No participation fee!

FOOD	Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be provided for you by the project. IMPORTANT: Please tell us if you have any special food needs (vegetarians, no pork, no fish, allergies etc.)
HOW TO GET TO REZEKNE	The airport to fly to is RIGA , Latvia . Please try to book your ticket for arrival in Riga as early as possible . When you will arrive to Latvia, get out from the airport, across the parking place you will find the bus stop (there is bus no.22) You can buy the tickets in the bus 2,00 Eur , but preferably next to the airport entrance door, on the left side, there is a little shop " Narvesen " or in the bus stop there is a tickets machine were you can find cheaper tickets 1,15 Eur . (in the bus 2,00 Eur) The bus No.22 will take you from the airport to the center of Riga. You need to get out in the bus stop " Autoosta ". The duration of the trip from airport to the bus stop "Autoosta" is 20-30 minutes. Check the map below, you can take the train in the train station or the bus in the Bus station for going to Rezekne . You can check the trains/busses to/from Rezekne on https://www.1188.lv/en/transport Buses you must check: from "RĪGAS SAO" to "RĒZEKNES AO" Trains: "RĪGA PASAŽIERU" to "RĒZEKNE 2" There you will find the convenient transport for you. If you are disorientated or lost, don`t hesitated to ask people or contact organizers!





REIMBURSEMEN T RULES	 The travel costs are covered up to a maximum amount according each country. Please note that if some of the participants are not traveling from the home cities of the partner organizations the reimbursement will be done according to the following rules: 1. If the travel distance is longer than the distance from the home city of the partner organizations the expenses will be reimbursed according to the project approved band
	distance (which is stated in the list above).
	2. If the travel band distance is shorter than the distance to the home city of the partner organization the expenses will be reimbursed according to the actual travel band.

	- Participants must choose the cheapest travel option. We will only reimburse public transport costs. No taxis will be reimbursed.
	- The reimbursement will be done only for travel expenses incurred according to the following rules:
	1. Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon full attendance of the project and presentation of the original travel tickets with boarding passes, receipts, invoices. All the original tickets, boarding passes and invoices from your home to the Rēzekne bus or railway station, including e-tickets, busses, trains, shuttles to the airport, etc. We're allowed to refund only the original tickets (alltogether including the return) once we'll receive physically by ordinary mail after the project. Your travel expenses will be reimbursed only upon presentation of documentary evidence of the sum actually paid: original invoice or/and a copy of credit card slip. We will ask you for the originals of ones you have already used; do a photocopy of the tickets, which you need for your return trip, and the rest you need to send us by post after the project.
	2. Electronic tickets will only be reimbursed on receipt proof of payment (invoice, paper of booking/purchase printed from internet, payment confirmation from Internet) and after presentation of the boarding pass for the outward journey.
	3. Boarding passes must be printed in PDF paper version. We will not accept mobile electronic boarding passes.
	4. Return tickets must be purchased before the start of the journey.
	Money transfer to your bank accounts (or your organizations bank account) will be after project, and after we receive all the necessary documents we asked for, from you. <u>We don't do reimbursements neither during training course nor in cash!</u>
	Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on the ticket and receipt/invoice. Any tickets purchased in a local currency other than EUR, will then be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate of the month or day when the ticket/s were purchased, as stated in the official European Commission web-site. For countries with other currency – we need to know the date of the purchase of the tickets, to make calculation of currency exchange according to the rules of Erasmus + programme.
	The reimbursement will be made by bank transfer only after receiving the original return tickets!!!!!!
	Please, bring with you all the bank details (IBAN; SWIFT code, Name of the Bank, Account number etc).
	Please do not book the tickets through travelling agencies. They are going to be much more expensive!!!
	Before the execution of the reimbursement, participants need to fill a questionnaire



WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU	 Please bring any medicine you might need. Motivation and good mood. We will try to hold some of our activities outdoors, so bring comfortable clothes and shoes. Alarm clock. 3 Please prepare presentations about your organization, your projects, work with youth. Each country will have 5-10 minutes. You can use different methods and techniques, but we prefer <i>PowerPoint</i>/ Prezi presentation to better understand what your organization is doing!!! 	
	INTERNATIONAL EVENING: - Each organization is asked to bring some food or drink and other typical national staff for the international evening.	
COVID measures	 EA "World-Our Home" is constantly organizing projects during this Covid-19 pandemic (as far as possible), so we have created strategy to protect project participants from possible infection. Having into consideration that the Covid – 19 pandemic is still ongoing, we will require the ONE OF the following documents/tests from ALL OF THE PARTICIPANTS: certificate of vaccination or valid recovery certificate (in phone or paper format); negative PCR test done no later than 72h before travel. 	
	 or negative antigen test if tested within the last 48 hours. PLEASE NOTE THAT WE CANNOT AFFORD TO REIMBURSE THE PARTICIPANTS FOR THEIR TESTS. *The project was applied before the pandemic and we do not have these costs calculated in our budget. Requirements for people: In the shop, public transport and other public places it is necessary to wear: a medical mask, or respirators (FFP2-FFP3). Medical masks or respirators must be used also for vaccinated people. 	



PLEASE REMEMBER that it is essential that participants participate **in all days of the training!** Otherwise we can't reimburse any money for the tickets.
